Two certifications, one system

ISO 22000 is the basic design of a food safety system: What the programme should do, what documentation we need to provide to our customers, how our programme should be reviewed by management, and how it can be continuously improved.

PAS 223 is the prerequisite programme, the nuts and bolts of how to guard against food safety risks and prevent problems in a food packaging plant: Cleaning schedules, employee health and hygiene, and building security.

Together, the two standards form a very stringent system for food safety in packaging manufacturing.

ISO 22000 / PAS 223 are not “audits in a box.” The

achievement of this dual standard took Chantler years of effort and commitment at all levels of the company, creating an organizational transformation around food safety and customer satisfaction.

Maximizing food safety

All aspects of our manufacturing have been examined with the goal of maximizing food safety.

We have controls in place to: inspect raw material, blend resins to achieve food contact regulatory compliance (CFIA, FDA & EU), sanitize production equipment, prevent foreign object contamination during manufacturing, protect the security of our plant, and recall product in the event of a nonconformance.

And we can generate the documents that our customers need to address the concerns of their customers: the global food retailers.
